But through our early childhood relationship with our primary caretakers our Soul becomes structured into a self-representation. This sense of who we take ourselves to be is primarily formed in relationship with our mothering figure. The 3rd part of this object relationship is the emotional affect between the child and mothering figure such as love, anger, fear or desire.

This early object relationship is a filter from the past that overlays how we relate in our lives. By exploring and understanding our object relations we can see how we are restricted in relating in our lives and how we may become freer and more real.
