

Teachers, as well as family and friends of teachers, who are interested in donating to the TTF can do so by going to the [Donate](#) section. If giving by credit card, under "Designated Use", select the Teacher-to-Teacher Fund. If giving by check, fill out the "Gift Indication Form" and under "Designated Use" mark "Other," then in the comments line write in the Teacher-to-Teacher Fund. When you donate to the Teacher-to-Teacher Fund you can also specify whether you would like your donation to go into the "Current Needs Fund" or into the "Fund for Longer Term Support."

Donations made to the TTF through Friends of Ridhwan will generally be tax-deductible for U.S. citizens, but it is always wise to check with your tax advisor to see if you qualify. Non-U.S. citizens may also make donations to the TTF, but tax deductibility depends on the laws of the country of citizenship, as Friends of Ridhwan does not yet have tax-deductible status outside the U.S.

Even though Friends of Ridhwan is currently a U.S. non-profit, grants and loans from the TTF can be made to both U.S. and non-U.S. teachers.

Please note that donors to the TTF cannot designate a specific individual to receive the funds they are donating. It is up to the TTF committee to review teacher applications for financial support and determine which teachers qualify for and receive financial aid, as well as the amount given.
